Zimmerman-Markley Community Service Award Scholarship at BGSU State Fire School

The Zimmerman-Markley Community Service Award has been established to assist the efforts of the continuing education and certification of current fire and rescue volunteers located in Champaign and Miami County, Ohio. Preference will be given to the following fire departments: Christiansburg Volunteer Fire Department, Casstown Volunteer Fire Department and the St. Paris Volunteer Fire Department.

Multiple scholarships may be granted annually to a qualified member of the above named fire companies so that they may attend the BGSU State Fire School to enrich their training and preparation as a volunteer.

CRITERIA

1. The applicant must be an active firefighter, paramedic, or EMT on a fire department located in Champaign or Miami County, Ohio.
2. Full-time, part-time, and volunteer firefighters and emergency service professionals are eligible to apply.
3. A selection committee, appointed by BGSU and the State Fire School Advisory Board, will review applications and give preference to applicants from fire departments with limited professional development funds.
4. Need will be determined based on information provided through a standard application form. This information will include fire district population, annual training budget, number of fire and emergency service personnel, and a brief narrative describing how attendance at State Fire School will benefit the applicant and community.
5. Preference will be given to the following fire departments:
 - Christiansburg Volunteer Fire Department
 - Casstown Volunteer Fire Department
 - St. Paris Volunteer Fire Department
6. Publicity generated by Bowling Green State University or the Zimmerman-Markley Community Service Award may include the scholarship's name and its purpose, as well as biographical information about the recipient.
